

South River United Methodist Church Scholarship Fund

Scholarship Guidelines

1. The South River United Methodist Church Scholarship Fund is for High School graduates who are enrolled at a college, university, technical school or community college.
2. The scholarship principle fund shall be created from donations, memorials, gifts, special offerings and grants. The principle of the fund shall not be invaded unless designated to the ledger fund.
3. Until the Scholarship Fund is self-perpetuating, the interest from all non-designated savings funds and Certificates of Deposit will be placed in a ledger account of The Fund and used to pay scholarships.
4. The scholarship will be given to active professing members of South River United Methodist Church. Active is one who is in attendance in church and/or Life Group for at least 50% of their high school senior year and while attending a post-secondary institution, the recipient must attend a church, Life Group, outreach and/or Bible Study representing South River UMC at least 50% of the school year. Exception: If attending a local (less than 30 minute drive) post-secondary institution, they must attend South River UMC and/or Life Group at least 50% of the school year..
5. This scholarship will be in the amount of \$500 per year payable to the student and can be applied for a maximum of four times in the first four consecutive years following high school graduation.
6. Applications will be available in the Fellowship Hall Foyer literature stand and on the church website and must be returned to the fund administrator prior to entering school.
7. The fund shall have five administrators. The members to administer the Fund shall be the current minister, the Finance Chairperson and three at-large members who shall be nominated by the Nominations Committee and approved by the annual Charge Conference serving a three-year staggered rotation.
8. All recipients of a scholarship from South River United Methodist Church are encouraged to consider donations to the Scholarship Fund after graduation from an institution of higher learning to enable other youth of this church to benefit from this program in the future.
